Elul Zman 5785

Elul Zman begins Tuesday, 2 Elul 5785/August 26, 2025. There is regular seder on Tuesday morning, and therefore, all Talmidim are required to be in Yeshiva by Monday night August 25, 2025. The dormitory will open starting Sunday. The Zman ends Motzai Yom Kippur, 5786.

Simchas Torah is a Yeshiva celebrated Yom Tov and therefore mandatory for all Talmidim in E"Y.

Winter Zman 5786

Winter Zman begins on Wednesday, 30 Tishrei 5786/October 22, 2025.

Summer Zman 5786

Summer Zman begins on Tuesday, 4 Iyar 5786/April 21, 2026. There is regular seder on Tuesday morning, and therefore, all Talmidim are required to be in Yeshiva by Monday night, 3 Iyar 5786/April 20, 2026.

Dates for the end of Winter and Summer Zman are based on numerous factors and are we working on finalizing them. Once the dates are confirmed, they will be shared.

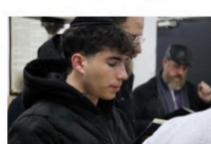
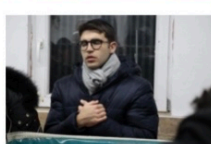
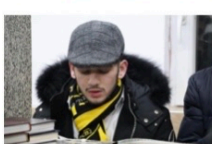
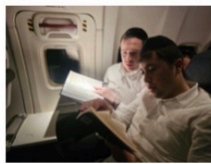
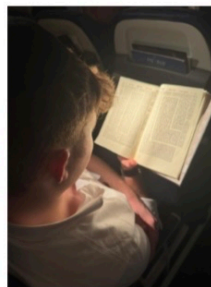
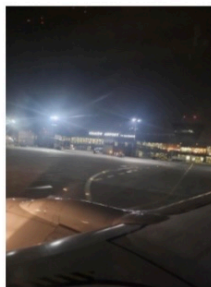
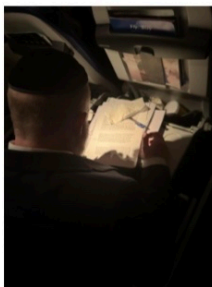
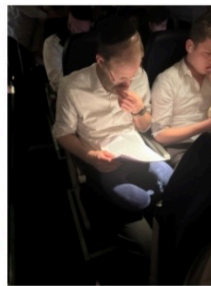
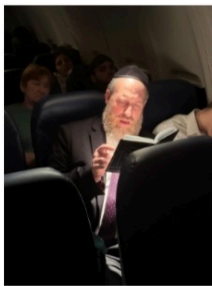
LIZHENSK TRIP RECAP DAY 1

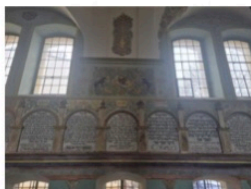
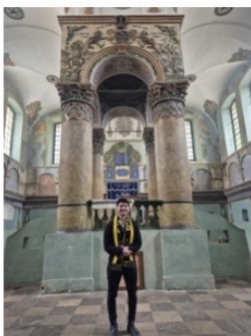
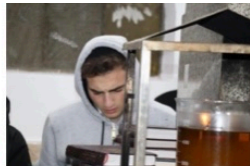
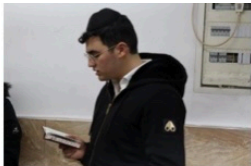
