Q- As a rebbe, what's the main quality you seek to instill into your talmidim?

A- The love for Torah! Everything in a Yid's life, from middos to raising a family, is all directly affected by one's engagement to Torah. These beis medrash years are prime, and in most cases, the only time to create that engagement. As in marriage, it is formed through love. That love for Torah learning is brought about in only **ONE** way- having fun and enjoying the learning! Once a bachur experiences this joy, he'll be able to make the choices of life with a new and different perspective.

Q- What is your derech halimud?

A- Following my high school/mesivta years in Monsey, I learned for two years in Kol Torah Yeshiva while R' Shlomo Zalman Auerbach zt"l was still Rosh HaYeshiva. Afterward, I went to learn for four more years in Be'er Ya'akov Yeshiva, where I acquired my derech halimud by the esteemed Rosh HaYeshiva R' Moshe Shmuel Shapiro zt"l. The derech halimud is based on the Brisker Derech, yet still very attached to shakla v'tarya and Rishonim based.

Q- How do you help bachurim deal with their struggles?

A- My main focus is to establish an enjoyment in the learning. The geshmack of the learning is one of the greatest powers (if not the greatest) that will help a Bochur through his challenges. I have seen on many occasions where there were serious struggles and distractions, but the bachur had this ta'am in learning - even if it wasn't for long periods of time – and he was able to overcome the challenges. Of course, there are situations that are beyond the regular, where there are more tools & methods to be used, inside and outside of Yeshiva.

Q- What do you enjoy about being a rebbe at Yeshivas Arzei Levanon?

A- The Rosh HaYeshiva, staff, location, the building and much more. There are two things that strike me the most (and they could be linked). First, the bachurim- we truly have the best group of bachurim in the world. They're all mentchen, eidle and bnei torah! Secondly, the vibe/atmosphere in and around yeshiva- it's a combination of a warm and relaxed environment **yet** at the same time full of excitement & growth!
