A special speech from Mr. Ephraim Holland an American who fought in the Yom Kippur War

Mr. Holland, now in his late 80's, was born in Brooklyn and moved to Israel as a teenager. He shared with the Talmidim his experience of having fought in The Yom Kippur War. His story was both fascinating and inspiring. The famous story of the Israeli soldiers being wrongly identified and shot at by the IDF at the battle of the Suez canal and being saved at the last minute by waving a Tallis to identify themselves as Jewish soldiers, was with HIS Tallis. But more importantly he shared a very impactful message with the Talmidim- the strong lessons in Emunah that he learnt from his life experiences and narrow escapes from death during those battles, and recognizing the Yad HaShem and the special Hashgacha Pratis that we all experience in our lives.
